I, as a good friend of Sudanese people, truly believe that my mission is to swiftly respond to a request for help from the Government of Sudan. In this regard, on August 8th, the Government of Japan decided to provide emergency assistance from a humanitarian viewpoint for the victims, as well as in light of long-lasting friendly relations between Japan and Sudan.

Therefore, I would like to extend my appreciation for the extraordinary efforts exerted by JICA staff under the strong leadership of Mr. Hiroyuki Mori, Chief Representative of JICA in Sudan.

This support is just the beginning. As a friend of Sudan, Japan has already made a firm commitment to support development of Sudan, and will continue its efforts to assist the Sudanese people who devote themselves for tackling the various challenges Sudan faces, including this terrible natural disaster.

By the way, when I met President Al-Bashir on the occasion of the Eid greetings at the Guest House on the first day of Eid Al-Fitr, I conveyed to him the details of the Japanese assistance. The President expressed his appreciation for the warm support from the people of Japan.
