Japanese Ambassador's Cup 2013 Went to the Hands of the Sudanese Wrestling Team "Lion's Heart"

Also, H.E. Engineer Mr. Adam Faki, Governor of South Kordofan State, and H.E. Mr. Al-Tayeb Hassan Badwi, Khartoum State Minister of Youth and Sports, Dr. Ammar Hamid Sulieman, Commissioner of East Nile Locality and Mr. Adam Mudair Abdel Sawad, Chairman of Khartoum State Sudanese Wrestling Federation participated in the ceremony and congratulated the honorable wrestlers.

Before the ceremony, Mr. Yasuhiro Murotsu, Head of Culture and Information Section, known as "Muro" a barefoot Japanese diplomat, finished his last match during his mission in Sudan.
