The Japanese Film Nights at Khartoum

From July 21st to 23rd, the Embassy of Japan in Sudan and the Ministry of Culture and Information, represented by External Information Council, organized the “Japanese Film Nights” at Sharjah Hall, University of Khartoum. The event came within the context of strengthening the cultural cooperation between Sudan and Japan.

In his speech, Mr. Murotatsu Yasuhiro, the Head of Culture and Information Section, highlighted that this is the first time which the Embassy of Japan in Sudan cooperates with the Ministry of Culture on the Japanese film screening. He expressed his appreciation to the Ministry and revealed the Embassy’s will to continue organizing similar events in the near future. He considered the event as a valuable opportunity for Sudanese people to know Japan and its culture. On the other hand, Madam Neimat Ali Gadallah, the Secretary General of External Information Council, Ministry of Culture and Information, expressed the activation of cooperation between the council and Embassy of Japan is the key for more harmonized bilateral relations between Sudan and Japan.

During the event, three Arabic subtitled Japanese films were screened. At the end of each film, comments were being received from the audience. One of them said “Japan is famous for its developed technology in Sudan, but through the films, we knew the other face of Japan, the characteristics of Japanese people and their social interaction that made me want to learn about Japan!”.
